

OFFICIAL FIELD RULES OF THE TEMECULA VALLEY FLYERS

To promote safety and as a courtesy to the other pilots, the Board of Directors of TVF has established the following flight regulations:

1. You must be a member of the AMA.
2. You must be a current member of the TVF, or guest of a member.
3. Guests must be escorted at all times by a current TVF member.
4. When other flight stations are occupied, all low passes, except during take-off and landings, shall be flown South of the South fence line. A low pass is considered to be below 30 ft. from the surface.
5. 3D type maneuvers, such as hovering, etc., flown below 30 ft., are not to be flown in front of any other occupied flight stations. It is recommended that 3D pilots use the far West station and keep their maneuvers West of that station.
6. When Jets are flown, only the pilot and crew are to be on the flight line. Spectators are to remain in the pit area.
7. Prior to walking "On the Runway," be sure everyone flying from a flight station is informed and you have received acknowledgement. Also, be sure to inform the parties when you are "Clear" of the runway.
8. Frequency control board will be used at all times.
9. Transmitters are not to be turned on until your frequency control pin is clipped onto the Control Board at the proper frequency location.
10. All gas and glow engines must be muffled. All engines must meet 96db at the center of the runway. All aircraft must be tested prior to flight.
11. No running of engines or electric motors in the area pit. Long duration engine testing and break runs are to be done at the area East of the shed, electric motors can be run at the West of the pits.
12. Prop blast to be directed away from the pits.
13. Do not fly over the pits, horse ranch, or parking area. All flights must remain over water districts land.
14. Only one airplane allowed at each flying station at a time.
15. Take your trash home with you. Plastic trash bags are provided in the outside locker for this purpose.
16. Clean your worktable when finished flying.
17. Spectators must remain in or behind the pit area.
18. Alcoholic beverages are not allowed at the field.
19. Hours of operation: Monday thru Friday (Electrics) 8:00 am to 5 pm (Nitro/Gas) 9:00 am to 5:00 pm. Field closed on Sunday.
20. Pets must be kept on a leash and remain in the pits or parking area.
21. All TVF members are responsible to abide by and assist in the enforcement of these regulations.
